What is a Functional Capacity Exam?

♦ A Functional Capacity Evaluation (FCE) is a complete evaluation designed to document a person's physical performance ability.

It may be requested for many reasons:

- ◊ To access your ability to return to a previous job following a surgery or an injury.
- To provide job modification recommendations or reasonable accommodations.
- ◊ To establish criteria for a safe return to work in a new job or career field.
- ◊ To assist with determination of disability rating.

Who performs FCE's?

♦ Generally the exam is done by a registered physical therapist.

How long will the FCE take?

It may take upwards of <u>4 hours</u> to complete.

Components of a FCE include, but are not limited to:

- ♦ Your medical history and your history of present illness.
- ♦ Total Body orthopedic evaluation.
- ♦ Pain and disability questionnaires.
- ♦ Cardiovascular evaluation.
- ♦ General strength evaluation.
- Ability to perform specific activities and tasks associated with work related job requirements and activities of daily living.
- ♦ Large and fine motor skill assessment.

Will my insurance cover the cost of the FCE?

- If you are looking to return to work and your injury or disability is work related, in most cases Worker's Compensation will cover the cost.
- ♦ Most other insurers will not cover the cost. The fee is your responsibility. the cost is \$600 (on average).
- Payment is often required upfront to secure an appointment since the exam takes 4 hours.
